The South East Grey Community Health Centre (SEGCHC) is pleased to announce that we will be partnering with the Erskine Presbyterian Church and the Township of Southgate to open a Satellite Clinic in Dundalk at 90 Artemesia Street to support care to our clients that reside in the Township of Southgate. We will be moving from our current site at the Dundalk Medical Centre. We will be open on Thursdays for the summer starting Thursday, July 6th for patients to see our nurse practitioner, dietitian and/or social worker. Our hours of operation are: 8:30 am to 4:30 pm. We will be expanding our services starting in September. We will also be offering several programs to all residents of Southgate and the surrounding area that will be free of charge such as senior's program, youth programs, cooking classes, exercise programs, card playing and Pilates.

The Community Health Centre opened in 2011 and serves over 6,000 patients looking after their primary care, health and wellness. Our main site is located in Markdale with additional satellite offices in Chatsworth and at the high school in Flesherton. Many of our patients are vulnerable and include a large proportion of seniors living in their homes in the community. Their care is a priority for us. The Centre is a charitable organization that is committed to providing health care and health promotion services to communities, seniors, youth and families.
